Organizational Setting

The Government of the Republic of Serbia, with technical assistance from the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), is implementing the project GCP/SRB/010/EC "EU for Sustainable Agriculture and Rural Development – pesticides (Enhanced national capacities for sound management of pesticides in the Republic of Serbia)." - Contribute to the design of the electronic pesticide registration and monitoring database (Act. 1.6), ensuring it meets technical requirements for user-friendliness, data accuracy, and EU alignment.
- Assist in the preparation of updated curricula, training materials, and manuals for professional pesticide users, inspectors, evaluators, and advisory staff (Acts. 2.1. 2.2 & 2.5).
